RACE OVERVIEW

Founded in 1925, and celebrating it's centenary year, the Rolex Fastnet Race is a biennial offshore yacht race organised by the Royal Ocean Racing Club. The race is named after the Fastnet Rock, which the race course rounds. The event is considered one of the classic big offshore races, and is a bucket-list race for any sailor.

The Fastnet Race is testing of both inshore and offshore skills, boat and crew preparation and speed potential. The 2025 edition is set to attract over 400 entries, including some of the world's best racing yachts. This is your chance to compete in this famous race and complete a full Fastnet Campaign.

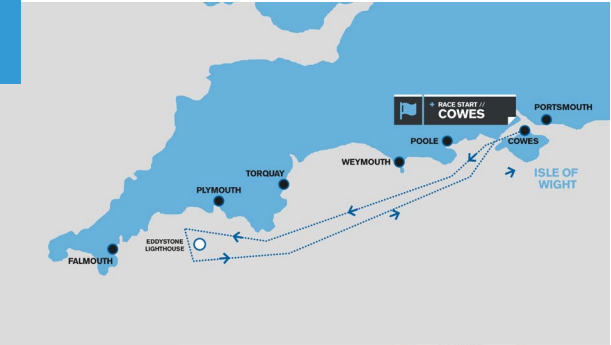

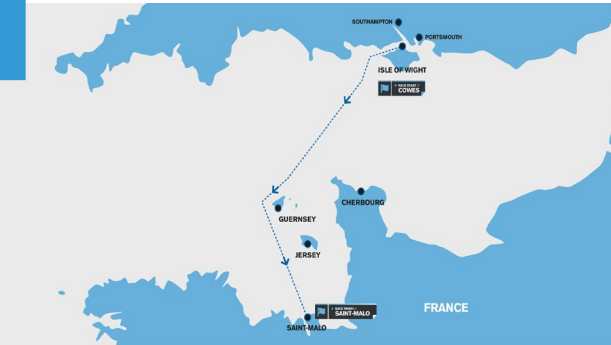

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

01

DEFINITIONS

This contract is made between Clipper Events (the Company) Registered in England, and any person(s) (the Client) booking with the Company to take part in any race, event, charter, or management-training event (the Programme). All bookings are subject to these terms and conditions and it is agreed between the Client and the Company that any contracts will be construed in accordance with English Law and the jurisdiction of English courts.

Information given by the Client via booking form or online or via a deposit forms the basis of a contract and the Client will be accepting the booking conditions for themselves and members of their party. If any part of these booking conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable then the remainder of these booking conditions will remain valid and enforceable.

BOOKING, FEES AND CHARGES

- Bookings made more than 60 days from the Programme start will be required to be a non-refundable £1000 deposit at the time of booking.
- Bookings made within 60 days of the Programme start date will be required to pay the full Programme cost.
- Booking Forms and personal information is kept according to the Clipper Ventures privacy policy which can be found [here](#).
- Final balance must be paid 60 days prior to the start of the first qualifying event or the company reserves the right to cancel the booking and charge a 50% cancellation fee as detailed under cancellation.
- In the event of a booking being made within 60 days of the first qualifying event, full payment will be required to confirm a booking.
- In the event of there being any fees due on the day of the event, the Company reserves the right to withhold the services unless payment is received. The Company reserves the right to charge interest of 1.5% above the Bank Of England rate on overdue accounts.
- The Company accepts Visa, MasterCard, and debit cards and bank transfers. All costs are subject to VAT.
- Should there be any additions/amends to the original quotation the costs will be amended accordingly.
- The Client shall not make this booking available for onward sale for profit or otherwise without prior written permission from the Company.

LIMITED LIABILITY

- The Company shall not be liable for any injury, death loss or damage caused by other Clients, nor will it be responsible for any uninsured losses of the Client's property, nor for any illness, injury or death sustained during the programme.
- The Company will use insured vessels for the event they are entered into.
- Clients agree if required to complete a release of liability form before embarking on a programme if required to by the Company or race organiser.

04

CANCELLATION

By the Company

- In the event of cancellation by the Company the Client may be given the choice of an alternate Programme where possible. If the Client does not choose an alternate Programme, then a full refund will be given.

By Client

- Cancellation by the Client must be in writing and is effective upon receipt by the Company.
- In the event of cancellation by the Client the following charges shall apply:
 - More than 90 days from the event start date: Loss of £1000 non-refundable deposit.
 - 90-31 days from the event start date: Loss of 50% of Programme cost.
 - Less than 30 days from the event start date: Loss of 100% of Programme cost.

Other reason

- In the event of a cancellation prior to the start of the Programme as a consequence of Force majeure, war, disease, actions of the Race Event organisers or Government advisories the Client may be given the choice of an alternate Programme.
- No liability is accepted by the Company for any costs or expenses incurred by the Client in the event of changes to the Programme or cancellation by the Company.
- In the event of cancellation, postponement, curtailment or changes to the advertised programme outside of the Companies control as a consequence of Force Majeure, war, disease or Government advisories or actions of the Programme or Event Organisers once the Programme has commenced, the Client may be given the choice of an alternate programme where possible. If the Client does not wish to choose an alternate programme, then a refund will be given. Alternate programmes or refunds offered will be proportionate to the point at which the cancellation, postponement, curtailment or changes to the advertised programme occurred.
- In the event that changes to the advertised programme occur the Company reserves the right to make such changes as required. The Company will pay no compensation to the Client(s) where change or cancellation to the programme is due to Force Majeure, war, disease or Government advisories, loss, damage or incapacity of the vessel or actions of the race event organisers.

CLIENT OBLIGATIONS

- Details supplied on the booking form are accurate.
- The Client agrees to abide by the normal operating and safety procedures as laid down by any third party suppliers to the event.
- Sailing requires an average level fitness and health, the Client is required to inform the Company of any pre-existing medical conditions of any of the participants prior to the start of the Programme.
- Clipper Events operates yachts for up to twelve guests on each boat, each event will consist of a minimum safety number of six guests, of which all are aged 18 or over on the day of the event.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- The Client agrees to accept the authority, decisions and instructions of the Company's Skipper's, employees, agents and representatives during the Programme.
- The Skipper has full authority to decide when to sail or race, with regard to weather conditions and the well-being of the crew, or to return to port after the commencement of a passage due to the above or defects to the yacht at any time at their discretion and their decision is final.
- The Company requires respectful conduct from its Clients and participants at all times.
- It is strictly prohibited to be under the influence of alcohol whilst engaged in the Company sailing activity. The skipper will ask you to leave the activity until you are fit to resume normal duties.
- Any use or possession of banned substances will be dealt with by expulsion from the event and will be reported to the relevant authorities.
